ADDENDUM #1

QUESTIONS FROM VENDORS

1. **Q. Has an estimated budget, start date, and completion date been established for ITB 21-01?**
A. Start Date: 04/14/2021; Completion Date is 60 days following the start date; Estimated Budget: \$35,000.
2. **Q. Clarify exactly what the Town of Dundee is asking for on page 45?**
A. The information on the individual page 45 should be completed by each bid package.
3. **Q. Will this be a 24' aluminum cantilever gate?**
A. Yes, the Cantilever Gate should be 24'.
4. **Q. Should the gate to recessed to the driveway?**
A. Yes, the entrance will be recessed for a 48' entrance off the road.
5. **Q. Will the fence removal going to be done by the Town?**
A. Yes, the fence removal will be done by the Town of Dundee.
6. **Q. Should the gate automatically open for an exit?**
A. Yes, the gate should automatically open for an exit.
7. **Q. Is fire emergency access necessary with the gate?**
A. Yes, fire access is necessary.
8. **Q. How many remotes will the Town want for the gate?**
A. The Town would like 6 remotes to the gate.
9. **Q. How long after receiving notice will the awarded lowest bidder be able to place the order to lock in prices?**
A. The awarded bidder will be notified within 24 hours of the ITB award being approved by the Town Commission on 04/13/2021 and the project process can begin immediately.
10. **Q. Should the information on general provisions #17 broken down on the bid form or is it all a lump sum?**
A. The information in general provisions #17 should be itemized with a lump sum of all items.
11. **Q. If another company's bid is lower on one line and ours is lower on the other, will there be more than one bid awarded?**
A. All items should be listed individually, to evaluate the bid line by line, however, there will only one bid awarded based on the lump sum of the bid.
12. **Q. Do you want each item listed individually on a different line or do you want them listed as a package (fence package, gate package, etc.)?**
A. Items should be in a detailed format so it will be clearly defined for Town Staff and Commission.

13. **Is a bond required for this project if it is over \$30,000?**

A. Yes, a bond is required for this project.

14. **Q. What does bid alternate mean?**

A. ITB Page 6, 4 (b):

b) Alternate bids shall not be considered unless alternate bids are specifically required by the technical specifications set forth in the Contract Documents. For purposes of this provision, alternate bids shall mean any bid which deviates from the specific type of product; method of construction; or plans specified in the ITB.
