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#### Section 1 Summary of Services

#### A. Introduction:

- 1. It is the intent of this Request for Proposals for Professional Services (RFQ) to hire a vendor (hereinafter Contractor) to provide professional services to coat a steel clarifier at the Town's Wastewater Treatment Plant (Wastewater Steel Clarifier Coating/Rehab).
- 2. It is the intent and purpose of this solicitation to promote competition. #### Rehab:

- 1. Demolish & dispose of existing air distributor piping & valves in digester tank.
- 2. Fabricate & install identical air distributor piping & valves with *all* 316 stainless steel.
- 3. Supply (10) 316 stainless steel rectangle air diffusers.

#### Surface Preparation:

- 1. Remove all grease, oil, dirt, dust, mold, mildew and other soluble contaminants by Pressure Washing (minimum 3500 PSI, 3-5 gallons per minute, potable water).
- 2. Remove all remaining contaminants and scarify all sound remaining coating (2.0 mils profile) by Brush off Blast Cleaning (SSPC-SP7).
- 3. Grind all bare metal edges and seams smooth. Remove all areas of rust and rust stain by Near White Blast Cleaning (SSPC-SP10).
- 4. All Surfaces must be clean and dry prior to the application of any coatings.

Surface preparation will begin by sandblasting the entire substrate removing all existing coatings also, preparing the surface so that it is structurally intact and clean of all corrosion. After sandblasting is completed, the surface area will be power washed at 4000 psi, ridding the substrate of all dust and sand. All sand will be removed from the structure along with other debris. A one (1) component, polymer modified, cementitious concrete will be applied rebuilding the substrate and acting as a resurfacer providing a smooth surface to spray and fixing any imperfections.

- **A.** Fund Availability: Any contract resulting from this RFQ is deemed effective only to the extent that funds have been appropriated and are available. The Town abides by the provisions set forth in Florida Statutes relative to the appropriation of funds.
- **B. Prompt Payment Act:** Payments will be made pursuant to section 218,70, Florida Statutes, Florida's Prompt Payment Act.
- Business Tax Receipt (formerly Occupational License):

  The Town requires a Local Business Tax Receipt (formerly Occupational License) be held by all its contractors. - Contracting Parameters: Upon receipt and ranking of all proposals, the Evaluation and Recommendation Committee (ERC) shall provide to the Commission its rankings and a recommended top-ranked firm. Approval of the top-ranked firm by the Commission will constitute an authorization to the Town Manager and/or authorized Town representative to negotiate with the top-ranked firm. Conflict of Interest: All proposers must disclose, with their proposal, the name of any corporate officer, director, or agent who is also an officer or employee of the Town. Furthermore, all proposers must disclose the name of any Town of Dundee officer or employee who owns, directly or indirectly, an interest of ten percent (10%) or more of the proposer's firm or any of its

branches, subsidiaries, or partnerships.

**G.** Additional Terms and Conditions: No additional terms and conditions included with the proposal response shall be evaluated or considered, and any and all such additional terms and conditions shall have no force and effect and are inapplicable to this solicitation. If submitted either purposely, through intent or design, or inadvertently, appearing separately in transmitting letters, specifications, literature, price lists, or warranties, it is understood and agreed the general and special conditions in this solicitation are the only conditions applicable to this proposal and the proposer's authorized signature affixed to the proposal signature section attests to this.

- H. Liability: The top-ranked firm and/or successful proposer(s) which negotiate and enter into a contractual agreement with the Town shall act as an independent contractor and not as an employee of the Town. The top-ranked firm and/or successful proposer(s) shall be required to indemnify, defend, and hold and save harmless Town, its officers, agents, and employees, from damages arising from the performance of, or the failure to perform, any task or duty required to be performed by the successful proposers.
- Indemnity: The successful proposers shall fully indemnify the Town.
- J. Insurance: During the entire period of performance of any contract resulting from this RFQ, the successful proposer(s) shall procure and maintain, at a minimum, the type, kind, and limits of insurance stipulated herein. Proof of such insurance shall be provided to the Town prior to beginning contract performance.
- K. Public Entities Crimes: A person or affiliate who has been placed on the convicted contractor list, following a conviction for public entity crime, may not submit a proposal on a contract to provide any goods or services to a public entity; may not submit a proposal on a contract with a public entity for the construction or repair of a public building or public work; may not submit proposals on leases of real property to any public entity; may not be awarded or perform work as a contractor, supplier, subcontractor, or consultant under a contract with any public entity; and may not transact business with any public entity in excess of the threshold amount provided in section 287.017, Florida Statutes, in CATEGORY TWO, for a period of thirty-six (36) months from the date of being placed on the convicted contractor list. By signature on this solicitation and confirmation on the attached form, the proposer certifies that it is qualified to do business with the Town of Dundee in accordance with all Florida Statutes.
- Acceptance of Services: Receipt of service shall <u>not</u> constitute acceptance. Final acceptance and authorization of payment shall be given only after a thorough inspection indicates that the performance meets the specifications and/or all conditions. Should the delivered service differ in any respect from the specifications, payment will be withheld pursuant to section 218.70, Florida Statutes, until such time as the successful proposer takes necessary corrective action. If the proposed corrective action is not acceptable to the Town, the Town may refuse final acceptance of the service.
- M. Firm Location: Principal place of business, headquarters, or other place of business for more

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than one (1) year within the legal boundaries of the Town of Dundee, Florida, prior to the solicitation issue date of this proposal.

To be considered a legitimate place of business, the location must be staffed by full-time employees; it shall be legally addressed to receive mail via the United States Postal Service and be serviced by public utilities or permitted alternatives. At no time shall a place of business located on Town owned property be considered for the purpose of earning Firm Location points. Attachment "H", Firm Location, shall be included in any proposal to be considered for receipt of evaluation criteria points based on firm location, if applicable.

The Town reserves the right to request additional information, if necessary, to document eligibility.

- **N. Minority Business Enterprise Preference:** In instances where two (2) or more of the highest ranked proposals are identical in every way, the proposer certified as a minority business enterprise under Florida Statutes will be favorably considered for the award.
- O. Drug-Free Workplace Preference: Whenever two (2) or more proposals are equal with respect to price, quality, and delivery, and services are received for procurement subject to Town of Dundee Administrative Code, a bid received from a business that certifies that it has implemented a drug-free workplace program shall be given preference, in accordance with section 287.087, Florida Statutes. Certification of an implemented drug-free workplace program must be included with the proposal when the proposal is submitted.
- Ρ. Audits and Records—Responsibilities of Successful Proposer: Before or after an agreement is prepared and executed, the successful proposer(s) may be required to disclose their financial condition in a manner specified by the Town.   - Introduction "TAB 1" (0 Points). This section will contain a cover letter signed by an authorized representative of the proposer. The table of contents will follow the cover letter. This section is not included in the overall page count. The letter should disclose the proposer and its location. Maximum 1 page
  - 2. <u>Firm Information "TAB 2" (10 Points)</u>. This section shall briefly describe the proposer's organization and structure, and this section shall also state if all work will be performed in the named office or if another branch office may be used. 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3. Project Approach "TAB 3" (20 Points). ## Section 6 Award or Rejection of Offers, General Criteria

- A. Evaluation Procedures. The Evaluation and Recommendation Committee (ERC) shall make all initial determinations and/or recommendations.
- B. Award of Contract. The ERC shall make a recommendation to the Commission regarding the firms it has chosen as the top-ranked firm. - **D.** Right to Reject. The Town reserves the right to accept or reject any and/or all proposals to this RFQ, or any part thereof, with or without cause, without recourse, to waive technicalities or irregularities, and to accept or reject proposals which, in the Town's sole judgment, best serve the interests of the Town.
- E. Proposal Results. The list of proposal responses should be available within forty-eight (48)

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hours of the opening date and time and can be viewed and/or read at www.townofdundee.com, interested proposers may also call the Town for results.

- F. Protests. Any party having actually submitted a proposal for this RFQ may protest the RFQ contract award by filing such a protest in writing to the Town Manager within three (3) calendar days, excluding holidays and weekends, after the contract award is made by the Commission. Filing such a protest shall stay all further contract negotiations and proceedings until all protest measures have been exhausted.
