JOB SUMMARY

Working at the Town Wastewater Treatment Plant performing manual and mechanical tasks relating to the daily operation of the wastewater treatment facility.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES

- Makes regular tours of plant and equipment assisting in wastewater plant operations.
- Monitors gauges, meters, control panels, etc.; controls tank levels and flow rates.
- Records readings from meters and instruments.
- Checks functioning of equipment.
- Operates computer system to control plant flow and machinery.
- Performs manual and mechanical tasks relating to the daily operation of a wastewater treatment facility.
- Physically adjusts valves and gates to adjust flow of sewage. Maintains written operational records; records meter and gauge readings; performs basic arithmetic calculations and interprets results.
- Cleans and performs routine maintenance and repair of tank wires, piping, waste treatment machinery and equipment.
- Physically handles various chemicals and materials. Safely operates trucks and tractors in the disposal of solid waste on a weekly basis.
- Monitors and makes chlorine feed rate adjustments.
- Operates sludge thickening and dewatering systems.
- Monitors telemetry system; calls out field crews for alarm situations.
- Performs general janitorial and groundskeeping functions; sweeps and mops floors and decks; mows, trims shrubbery and edges driveways and sidewalks.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS & ABILITIES

- Knowledge of the practices, methods, materials and tools utilized in the repair and maintenance of waste treatment machinery and equipment.
- Sufficient knowledge of basic electricity to affect minor repairs and adjustments.
- Ability to read, write, speak and understand English.
- Perform basic arithmetic calculations.
- Descend and ascend ladders and stairs to obtain access to affect necessary repairs.
- Withstand occupancy in confined spaces, non-claustrophobic.
- Work with and around chemicals.
- Work without direct supervision.
- Must exhibit attention to detail, accuracy, and safety.
- Must be able to communicate and present oneself in a professional manner.
- Ability to read, interpret and follow technical information, directives, manuals, memos, reports and other work-related materials.
- Ability to write analysis sheets, reports, inventories, logbooks, purchase orders and work requests.
- Ability to establish and maintain effective working and professional relationships with Town employees and officials, and the general public.
- Ability to take and follow oral instructions.
- Ability to work under high demands, short time constraints, and pressure of a fast-paced work environment.
- Ability to work shift work and respond to emergency call-out.
- Physical strength and agility sufficient to do strenuous laboring tasks under varying weather conditions.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Education & Experience:

Required knowledge and experience is normally obtained through the completion of a curriculum resulting in either a High School Diploma or GED is required.

Possession of a valid Florida Class "C" certification for wastewater plant operators or must obtain this certification within 12-18 months of employment. *The Town of Dundee supports and assists with education costs for employees seeking certifications in their work-related fields.*

Other Requirements:

Must possess a Valid Florida Class E drivers' license with a good driving record as determined by the Town of Dundee.

Must pass applicable pre-employment testing to include the absence of non- prescribed controlled substances in the applicant's system as verified by a laboratory approved by the Town of Dundee, and background checks.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

This position may be required to report for work for special events or when a declaration of emergency has been declared in the Town or in Polk County.
